Dear Friends...

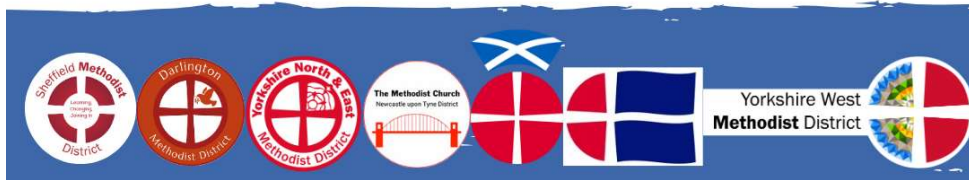
