Dear Friends...

For those who follow the church's liturgical year, during this next month we return to the season called 'Ordinary Time', having travelled through Lent, Holy Week and Easter, and then on to Pentecost and Trinity Sunday. Several months now lie ahead before we reach Advent at the beginning of December. 'Sundays in Ordinary Time' perhaps sound a bit boring and dull because nowadays the word 'ordinary' is most frequently used to describe something that is nothing special, just 'ordinary'.

However, the word's origin from the Latin 'ordo' means 'order'; so that ordinary, therefore, is something that is 'ordered'. Ordinary time then is a period of 'order', of measuring perhaps in the sense of an inner measuring, a noting, a savouring, an appreciating and reflecting upon the extraordinary times and celebrations.

'Extraordinary' occasions in our personal lives and in the life of the church are indeed wonderful and times to really celebrate but most of us I think would perhaps struggle with living in a constant state of excitement; constantly on the mountain top. We need to come down the mountain.

Those 'ordinary times' are when we have time to breathe; to take stock; and make steady progress in the reality of everyday life. In the midst of the 'ordinary' there will still be those extraordinary God moments if we're alert and ready to take notice! And not just on Sundays!
