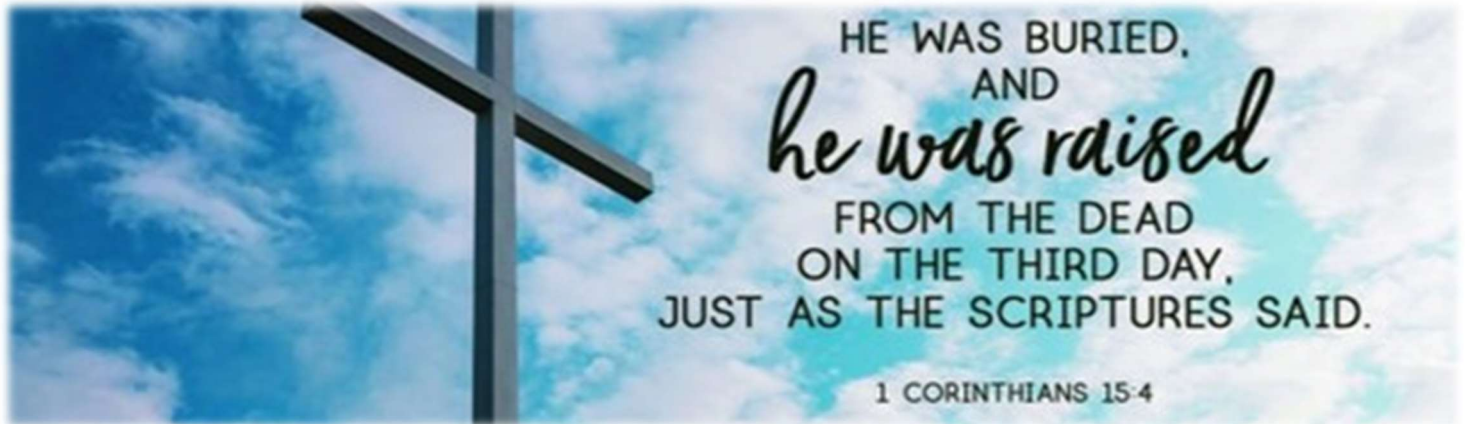

Dear Friends...

So, we continue our journey through the seasons of the year, seeing those signs of spring with new shoots. As I write this, the clocks are due to change at the weekend, and I guess we hope we will get it right and not be late for church! We will also, of course, soon journey through Holy Week.

It seems to me, that however we try to follow Jesus through that time it is important to try to enter into that experience and not simply move from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday – both days rightly full of joy and praise. There needs to be death before resurrection can happen. The reality of Jesus' resurrection is not easy for any of us to grasp or believe; perhaps we do want to move on quickly to Easter Day; perhaps we question as Thomas did; or most particularly perhaps we question where the resurrection is for our life today? There are so many places where we see wounds and scars as people struggle with illness, disappointment, relationships, or where people have no opportunity for education, go hungry, are homeless, fleeing for their lives and so many circumstances.

The resurrection of Jesus does not deny the pain and wounds of life; it is not a pretty picture covering up difficult, nasty things. It is about the reality of Jesus' painful death before a glorious Resurrection to new life, giving life and hope for all for all time. We celebrate and meet the Risen Lord, whose presence we can now experience and know every day. Alleluia He is alive!

Every blessing for a happy and joyful Easter!

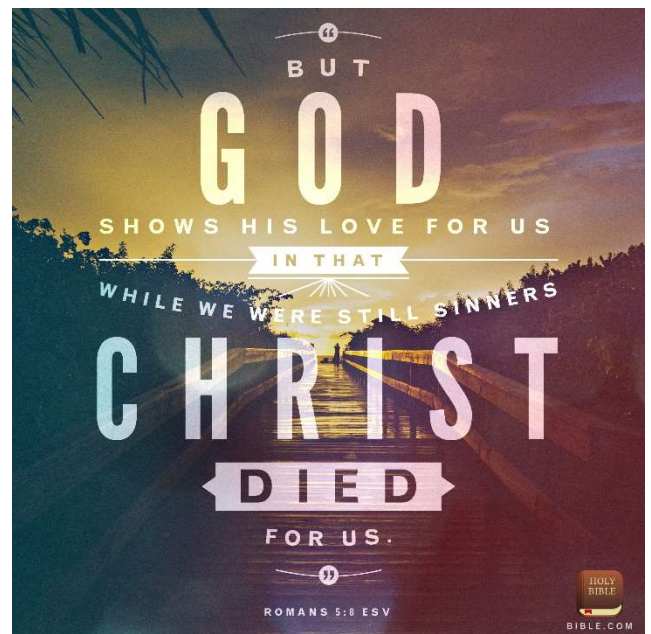
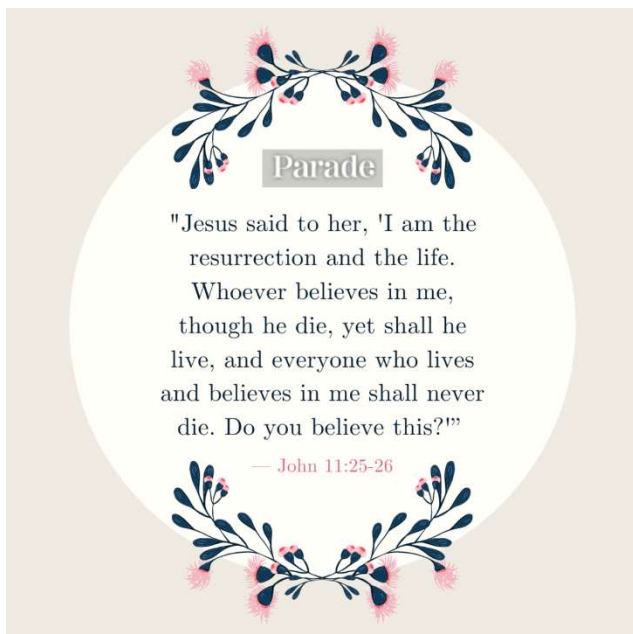
