
## Welcome

## 'Open the Book'

'Open the Book' (OtB) is an initiative of the Bible Society. It offers primary school children an opportunity to hear key Bible stories told by a team of Christians from local churches, who present the stories during assemblies or acts of collective worship. Each presentation takes around 10–15 minutes and can be incorporated into a wider school assembly or can stand alone. It is a three-year rolling programme with an additional, but optional year of material based on Christian values for schools.

Some of us visit three local schools, Garton, Sledmere and Wetwang, on Tuesday mornings during term time to deliver a different Bible story each week. During Covid lockdown, we have continued to do so virtually, with the addition of Barmby Moor school, thanks to work by the two heads of the schools and Zoom.

After the Summer holidays, we will be able to visit the three schools once again.

Since lockdown began, we have lost the services of **4 of our team, (of 7)**, who have taken part for a number of years, and we are now looking for new volunteers. We are a friendly bunch of people who would welcome anyone who can help. Although we visit the schools on a weekly basis, it will not be necessary to take part every week.
